

# One Button Studio (OBS) Dos and Don'ts

- IMPORTANT – Don't move any of the OBS equipment.
- Don't bring food or drink into the studio.
- Do place the “**Do Not Disturb**” sign on the door.
- Do leave the Presentation Clicker in the studio (don't take it with you).
- IMPORTANT – Don't move any of the OBS equipment.
- Do use ONLY the X-keys Keypad. The traditional keyboard is not necessary - using it will cause problems.
- Do take YOUR flash drives with you.
- Don't use the studio without a reservation.
- IMPORTANT – Don't move any of the OBS equipment.
- Do call the IT Service Desk at 903-334-6603 if you need help.
- Remember, these videos are for university projects – keep them clean and professional.
