**Project Name:** Downward Expansion

**Summary:** The exceptional item request to the 81st Legislature stated that funding would be utilized to hire faculty to provide the programs and adequate class sections as the university accepts freshmen and sophomore enrollment in Fall 2010 for the first time. The target for new enrollees is 300 to 400 students. Funding will also provide support staff to student related areas, scholarships, faculty and staff development in the "First Year Experience" program, and tutorial and developmental education to assure maximum retention. The enrollment growth will respond to the state "Closing the Gaps" goals and to the university's progress toward becoming a comprehensive regional university. Student success will be the major focus.

(The 78th Legislature passed House Bill 1566 allowing for the downward expansion of A&M-Texarkana at a new site. Construction of the multipurpose library and central plant buildings will be completed in early summer 2009, providing the facility space required for admission of the first freshman and sophomore classes.)

**Outcomes/Outputs:** Freshman and sophomore headcount, semester credit hour production, retention rates, and measured student success.
