4. Once we have received all your transcripts and you have been admitted, check out your DegreeWorks Degree Evaluation in Web for Students. DegreeWorks will show you how your classes from other universities transferred to TAMUT and what classes you still need to take.

5. CONNECT WITH US
Utilize your AceMail & Web for Students account for important information regarding your Admissions & Financial Aid status. Once you're admitted, please complete the following steps through Web for Students:

- Submit a housing application and fee for Bringle Lake Village
- Upload documents for proof of bacterial meningitis compliance at least ten days prior to the first day of classes in the semester at which you are attending
- Register for Student Orientation, Registration & Advising (SOAR). Sessions are mandatory for all new students.

Transfer ADMISSION STANDARDS

- Any post-secondary transferable credit in a full term (Fall or Spring) after high school/GED completion. If a student only attends the summer term immediately following high school completion they will still be considered a freshman and;
- 2.0 grade point average (GPA) or higher

- Total aid awarded for the 19/20 school year was over \$18 million
